## *Layout Requirements for Papers*

1. The manuscript is accepted in A5 size (148x210 mm) with the extensions .doc, .docx (MS Word 2003, 2007) in paper and electronic versions identically presented. Margins: Left – 2; Right – 2; Top – 2; Bottom – 2.2. Gutter – 0. Orientation – Portrait.

### 2. Text

- Font size – 10.
- Line spacing – 1.0.
- Paragraph indent – 0.5.

### 3. Tables

- The table width should not exceed the width of A5 size.
- The font size of the table text – 9.
- The font size of the table header – 8.

### 4. Formulas

- Microsoft Equation 3.0 as a formula editor should be used.
- Latin characters – italic font.
- Greek and Russian characters – regular font.
- Formulas should be centered between the page margins and spaced from the body text.
- Note that numbering of formulas is required only for the formulas having in-text references.

### 5. Illustrations

- The width should not exceed the width of A5 size.
- Vector images – Visio.
- Bitmap images – extension of 300 dpi. TIF
- Illustrations edited with MS Word should be grouped.

### 6. References

- References should be arranged alphabetically.
- References should be made according to GOST 7.1–2003 (bibliographic record, bibliographic description, general requirements and rules of compilation).

### 7. Information about the author (co-authors)

- The initials (name) and surname.
- Scientific degree, academic title.
- Faculty, department (for students).
- Master Student, PhD Student, PhD Candidate (specify).
- Full name of the university, city.
- E-mail, mobile phone.
