Member of the Synod of the Evangelical-Augsburg Church in Poland and a member of the tripartite commission of Evangelical Churches in Poland. In 2007-2012, he was a member of the Scientific Council of the *Institut für Diasporawissenschaft in Leipzig*. He coordinates the cooperation of ChAT with the University of Bonn, the Evangelical College in Nuremberg and the Evangelical College in Freiburg im Breisgau. He also lectures at the Maria Grzegorzewska University in Warsaw.
